### TOXICITY

### PRECAUTIONS

PERSONAL PROTECTION Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with skin and eyes, ingestion. When applying this product, overalls, boots, gloves, eye protection should be worn. Wear respiratory protection if there is a risk of dust inhalation. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Clean protective clothing before re-use. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace.

### STORAGE

Store in original container, tightly closed, in a locked, dry, cool and well-ventilated area avoiding direct sunlight and away from

foodstuffs, fertilisers or seeds. Storage must be in accordance with the current version of Management of Agrichemicals (NZS 8409)

Stores containing 1000 kg or more of AGPRO Fertiliser Tablets require secondary containment, signage and an emergency plan. DISPOSAL

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Dispose of this product only by using according to the label directions or if this is not possible contact your supplier for advice.

PACKAGING DISPOSAL: Dispose of empty packaging at an approved landfill. Do not burn. Do not use packaging for any other purpose.

### FIRST AID

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

AGPRO Fertiliser Tablets contain a blend of Nitrogen. Phosphorous, Potassium, Magnesium and trace elements in a balanced formulation for use in orchards, forestry, vinevards and nurseries

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Plants up to 300mm high	1 to 3 tablets
Plants 300mm – 1m high	2 to 5 tablets
Plants over 1m high	5 tablets plus
