## PRECAUTIONS

## PERSONAL PROTECTION

## STORAGE

## EQUIPMENT

## DISPOSAL

**PRODUCT DISPOSAL:** Dispose of this product only by using according to the label directions or if this is not possible contact your supplier for advice.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL.** Triple rinse container and add rinsate to the spray tank. Recycle clean containers at an Agrecovery depot, or puncture and dispose of at an approved landfill. Do not burn. Do not use container for any other purpose.

## FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:** Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call the Poisons Centre or doctor.

## SPILLAGE

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**AGPRO Crop Oil** can be mixed with various herbicides whenever a crop oil is recommended on the label. The mixing rate of **AGPRO Crop Oil** is 500ml-1L per ha of spray mix. Use the higher oil rate when applying water rates over 200L/ha.

## MIXING

Always follow the mixing instruction of each ingredient in the tank mix. Ensure product compatibility. When tank mixing, use the following general mixing order. Water dispersible granules first, then flowable formulations, then emulsifiable concentrates, then water soluble liquids and then the Crop Oil. Fill the tank to the required volume while agitating.
